#### Notes.

The API for joint publications will have to be calculated in the following manner:

- Single author 100% of total points
- Two Authors: First/Principal author and the corresponding author / supervisor / mentor 60% of the total points to each.
- Three or more authors: First/Principal author and the corresponding author / supervisor / mentor 60% of the total points to each. Third and Forth authors 40% of the total points to each. More than four authors are not considered.
