Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (PB)

A brief Introduction

Baba Farid University of Health Sciences established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine.

Established as it is with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educations in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving the goal.

The University now encompasses 132 affiliated colleges and 5 Constituent Colleges (with an aggregate of 24,000 students). Faculty-wise distribution is 10 Medical, 15 Dental, 95 Nursing, 12 Physiotherapy and 1 Sports Medicine. The University has recently added to its academic convoy Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System.

Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala (PB)

A brief Introduction

Punjab Technical University (PTU) was established in the Year 1997 under the Punjab Technical University Act, 1996 (Punjab Act No. 1 of 1997) to provide for the establishment and incorporation of a University for the advancement of technical education and development thereof in the State of Punjab and for matters connected therewith. In pursuance of this Act, the University started its journey with 09 engineering colleges and few management colleges affiliated to it. Since then, the University has come a long way and during this Academic Session 2011-12, the University has affiliated 100+ engineering Colleges, 139 Management and Computer Application courses, 37 institutions imparting Pharmacy education, 11 colleges imparting Hotel Management education, 06 Colleges providing Architecture Education and 21 Regional Centre for M. Tech and Ph.D in different branches of Engineering and Management and 01 Regional Centre for M. Pharmacy. More than 2013 Learning Centres of PTU are providing professional education through Distance Learning all over the Country and abroad.

At present, PTU is providing education to approximately 5 lac students in the fields of Engineering, Management, Architecture and Pharmacy. This number includes 50 percent students form the states other than Punjab.

The genesis of collaborative studies between BFUHS, Faridkot and PTU, Kapurthala goes back to a meeting held in 2010 at Government level wherein Hon'ble Vice-Chancellors of both the universities were present. After prolonged discussions between faculty members of both the Universities and higher authorities of the State Government, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 08.04.2011 between the two universities to start joint courses. These courses will be of multidisciplinary subject nature integrating professional engineering activities with basic medical knowledge of functioning of the human body. These courses will be aimed to improve hospital management.

The government of India is also paying attention on providing health care in both rural and urban areas. The requirement of professional administrators in the hospitals is growing at a rapid pace primarily because the nature of work in hospitals is quite different from other organizations. Hospitals are expected to deliver quality service 24 hours a day at a minimal cost. The urgent nature of its work and the level of efficiency that is expected have increased the need of well-formulated hospital management courses throughout the world.

With the aim and objectives highlighted above, the joint boards of studies (BFUHS and PTU) have already started making admissions to the following courses from 2012:

- 1. PG Diploma in Hospital Engineering & Management
- 2. Masters in Public Health & Engineering

These courses were designed as joint venture of imparting education for preparation of specialists to deal with administration and setting up and running of hospitals to meet the requirements of present times.
