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1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. In order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority and to empower the citizens to secure access to information under the control of each public authority, the Government of India have enacted "The Right to Information Act, 2005", (RTI Act) which came into force on 15.06.2005. In accordance with the provisions of section 4(1) (b) of this Act, Bangalore University has brought out this Manual for information and guidance of the general public.
- 1.2. The purpose of this Manual is to inform the general public about the organizational set-up of Bangalore University, the functions and duties of its officers and employees and records and documents available with the University.
- 1.3. This manual is aimed at the public in general and users of the services and provides information about the Rules, Regulations, Statutes, Schemes, Projects and Programmes being implemented by the University under its administrative control.
- 1.4. The procedure and fee structure for getting information are as under:-

A request for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of section 6 of the RTI Act shall be made in writing, either in person or by post to the Assistant Public Information Officer concerned and must be accompanied by an application fee of **Rs.10/-** by way of Indian Postal order & DD in favour of the Finance officer Bangalore University Bangalore.

- (2) (a) For providing information under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Right to Information Act, Rs.2/- for each page in respect of matters in A4 size paper. shall be charged.

¹[(aa) for providing information disseminated under the sub-section (4) of Section 4 shall be **Rupee One per page** in respect of matter in A4 size]

- (b) For providing information under (1) of section 7, in the case Maps, Plans, Reports, a partial record or any technical data or sample or models, a reasonable fee shall be fixed by the Assistant Public Information Officer in each case depending upon the cost of labour and material required to be employed.
- (c) As regards inspection of records and documents, no fee for the first hour. For every subsequent half an hour ² [or fraction thereof, Rupees ten] shall be charged from persons making application with initial payment as prescribed under Rule 4(1) above. For inspection of works a reasonable fee shall be fixed by the Assistant Public Information Officer in each case depending upon the

cost of labour and material required to be employed apart from initial fees as prescribed under Rule 4 (1).

- (3) For providing the information under sub-section (5) of section 7, the fees for supplying information in Diskette or Floppy or C.D. or in any other Electronic Mode shall be Rs. 50/-.
 - (4) the fee shall be collected in the form of Indian Postal Order or DD or Bankers Cheque or pay Order drawn in favour of the Finance Officer or by remitting as per Karnataka financial code (KFC).
- 1.5. Persons below the poverty line are exempted from the payment of fee mentioned in paragraph 1.4 above for seeking information under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The list of persons below poverty line approved by the Gram Panchayat and local bodies will be the basis for claiming this concession. An extract of the list, duly certified by the concerned Tahsildar will be sufficient to avail this concession.
 - 1.6. The Officer mentioned below is appointed as **Nodal Officer** to liaison the work pertaining to Right to Information Act as per Bangalore University RIA Manual.



2. Particulars of organisation, functions and duties under (Section 4(1)(b)(i);

BANGALORE UNIVERSITY ORGANISATIONAL CHART



Objectives : -

- To develop and maintain the educational institutions under the Bangalore University dedicated to organization, conduct and promotion of educational pursuits for under-graduate and post-graduate studies.
- To initiate, sustain and promote research in various faculties of studies in the University
- To undertake endeavours to sub serve the above objects.

Brief History:

Bangalore University came into existence in July 1964 as an offshoot of the University of Mysore, primarily to include institutions of higher learning located in the metropolitan city of Bangalore and the districts of Bangalore Rural and Kolar. The Garden city of Bangalore aptly hailed as the “IT capital of India”, enjoys salubrious climate. To start with, the two premier colleges of the city, the Central College and the University Visveswaraya College of Engineering formed the nucleus of the Bangalore University. Soon after the establishment of Bangalore University, as a first step in the reorganization of courses of instructions, the University introduced Honours courses in the year 1965-66. Three-year Honours courses in Botany, Chemistry, Economics, English, Geology, Kannada, Mathematics and Zoology which were conducted only at the University postgraduate departments, attracted many brilliant students. All Honours-passed students were admitted to postgraduate courses on priority and B.A., and B.Sc., graduates who marginally missed admission to the postgraduate courses were given an opportunity to join the final year Honours course and seek admission to postgraduate courses thereafter. Since 1964, Bangalore University has grown both in size and strength to include a large number of affiliated colleges, P.G. Centers of Research and a rich diversity of programme options. In consonance with this expansion, in 1973 the University acquired a sprawling new campus named ‘JNANA BHARATHI’ (JB) and shifted many of its postgraduate departments to this newly established campus. At present, the JB campus houses the Examination Branch Administrative Office and a large number of postgraduate departments, directorates, centers of higher learning and support services. The Central College campus is retained as the city campus which houses the main City Offices of the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Finance (Examination part), Academic Staff College, Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education and a few postgraduate departments and support services. Apart from this, in the vicinity of the city campus, the University has its constituent the University Visveswaraya College of Engineering (U.V.C.E. started in 1917) The University Law College (formerly known as the

Government Law College started in 1948) is in Jnana Bharathi Campus. The third constituent college, the University College of Physical Education (formerly known as the Government College of Physical Education, started in 1959) is located on the JB campus. Since 1973, the University is functioning from both the campuses – the main campus at Jnana Bharathi and the city campus at Central College.




The Bangalore University has completed forty two years of fruitful existence and has come to be hailed as one of the largest Universities of Asia. Though originally intended to be a federal university, it has eventually emerged as an affiliating university. In 2001, the University has been accredited by NAAC and has received **Five Star Status**. The NAAC has reaccredited the Bangalore University during 2008 with ‘**A**’ Grade. Academically, the university is structured into **six** faculties- Arts, Science, Commerce and Management, Education, Law and Engineering. It has **40** postgraduate departments, **one** postgraduate centre (at Kolar, started during 1994-95), **three** constituent colleges, more than **600** affiliated colleges (of which **84** have PG courses) and several other centres and Directorates of Higher learning and Research under its purview. At present, the University offers over **50** post-graduate courses.

The Bangalore University has achieved a milestone by establishing MoUs with **24** universities and institutions of National and International repute. To be able to cater to a student population of over three lakhs the University has constantly striven to maintain quality and efficiency in Higher Education.

Duties of the University:

1. To conduct academic programmes for the preparation of under-graduate and post-graduate examinations in various faculties available in the University, and to undertake activities that are contributory to this object.
2. To carryout Research on various frontier issues of Science and issues of science relevance.
3. Extension activities.

Main activities/functions of the University include:-

-  To conduct research in various branches of learning available in the University.
-  To conduct designated courses and examinations and facilitate students through formal and also non- formal education stream like Correspondence and Distance Education by the Directorate.
-  To facilitate the conduct of add-on courses of duration shorter than the regular ones.

- 🏆 To undertake various activities so as to supplement the efforts of research and teaching for various degrees and diplomas. This would also include conferring honorary degrees and cooperation with other Universities/other institutions/other bodies.
- 🏆 To establish specific centres for specialized studies in any branch of learning.
- 🏆 To take action for institution, maintenance and extension of awards, fellowships, scholarships, prizes etc.
- 🏆 To maintain colleges and halls of residence.
- 🏆 To undertake extension activities in the areas relevant to society.

Six persons nominated by the State Government for a term the three years from amongst eminent educationists of whom one belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes; one belonging to the other backward classes; one representing the women; one representing the religious minority and two representing others.

2. Information, disclosure of which would prejudicially affect the sovereignty and integrity of India, the security, strategic, scientific or economic interests of the State, relation with foreign State or lead to incitement of an offence;
3. Information which has been expressly forbidden to be published by any court of law or tribunal or the disclosure of which may constitute contempt of court;
4. Information, the disclosure of which would cause a breach of privilege of Parliament of the State Legislature;
5. Information which would impede the process of investigation or apprehension or prosecution of offenders;
6. Part of a document where law or regulation prohibits the University from providing the part or portion of a document.
7. Information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interests, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information.
8. Annual Confidential Report (ACRs) of officers and employees.
9. Any other information which University classifies as confidential from time to time.
