1. Name of the candidate shall be as in the Qualifying Certificate and the Ph.D Registration Order.
  2. The following enclosures should form part of the application.
    - (i). Hall Ticket format with the columns filled in, alongwith photograph, as per directions.
    - (ii) Self attested copy of the Qualifying Certificate.
    - (iii) Copy of the Ph.D Registration Order duly attested by the Research Guide.
    - (iv) Self Attested copy of the original M.Phil degree diploma.
    - (v) Chalan –slip in original for the prescribed examination fee.

(DD drawn from SBT/SBI payable at SBT, Kannur University Campus Branch, in favour of the Finance Officer, University of Kannur may be submitted. Those who remit the fee by means of DD shall pay an additional amount of ₹.20/- along with the examination fee, towards DD handling charges.

  - (vi) Self addressed, duly stamped envelope (23x11 cms) for sending the hall ticket by registered Post.

3. The Research Scholars will be allowed to continue their research programme only on production of their coursework pass certificates.

5. Maximum marks : 100

### INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES:

Those reporting after half an hour from the commencement of Examination will not be admitted to the examination hall. Persons suffering from infectious diseases will not be admitted for the examination. **Candidates should bring their hall ticket for the examination and make it available for verification by the invigilator on duty or by any other authorized person.**
2. Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their hall tickets/question papers. They are also prohibited from writing their names on any part of the answer books. Further they shall not write their Register number on any part of the answer book, except in the space provided for in the facing sheet.
3. Candidates are not allowed to carry mobile phones in the examination hall.
4. Calculators can be used in certain examinations with the permission of the Chief Superintendents of the examination centres.
5. Candidates cannot leave the Examination hall prior to 30 minutes from the closing time of Examination.
