V. <u>DEFINITIONS/RELAXATIONS AND SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXSERVICEMEN</u>

Ex-Servicemen who are Havildar, Lance Naik or Sepoy in the Army or equivalent rank in the Air Force or Navy are eligible to apply for the post of **Assistant Sub-Inspector/Steno**. Ex-servicemen holding the rank of Subedar, Nb-Subedar, Havildar/Naik or equivalent rank in the Army/Air Force/Navy may also compete in this recruitment for lower post provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria and also they furnish their willingness in writing that in the event of their selection they will not claim the post equivalent to the rank they were holding in the Defense Forces.

 - a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as a noncombatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union;
 and
 - a) who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension or
 - b) Who has been relieved form such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension or
 - c) Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment.

- 2. Break in Service: Should not be more than 03 years from the date of discharge from Army/Navy/Air Force as on 28.02.2017 including for the candidates of North East region.
- **3. Medical Category**: "A"(AYE)/ "SHAPE-I" at the time of discharge. They should also possess the same medical standards prescribed for direct recruits for the post of Assistant Sub Inspector/Steno in CISF.
- **4.** Character on discharge: Exemplary/Very Good.

The other eligibility conditions will be the same as applicable to direct candidates as mentioned under eligibility criteria.

VI. SCHEME OF RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF ASI/STENO:-

- 1. Candidates whose applications are found to be in order shall be called for further stages of recruitment. Verification of eligibility standard will be qualifying in nature i.e. no marks will be awarded for these tests, but candidates must qualify each stage to proceed further in the recruitment. Failure to qualify in any stage will result in elimination of the candidate from the recruitment process:-
- 1. Candidates have to appear in all stages of Recruitment for which they have qualified. If a candidate is absent from any stage/event for which he has qualified, his candidature will be cancelled.
- 2. Verification of Eligibility Standards (Physical Standard test)

Eligibility standard will be verified as enumerated in Para-III of this Notification.

3. Written Examination

Objective type question paper to be answered on OMR sheet of 100 marks of 02 hours duration containing 100 questions on General Intelligence, General Studies/Elementary science, General English or Hindi and Arithmetic.

Note:-The qualifying mark of 35% for General and 33% for SC/ST/OBC/Exservicemen does not mean that all candidates who have scored 35% & 33% as the case may be will be called for next stage. The candidates for next stage will be called i.e. skill test purely on the basis of their performance/marks score in written examination and cut off marks (category wise) which will be fixed after completion of written examination.

4. Re-evaluation of OMR sheets will not be considered.

5. Skill test norms on computer –

Shorthand Dictation will be of 10 minutes. For a dictation of 10 minutes there would be about 800 words @ 80 words per minute for transcription and subsequent typing. The time for transcription will be 50 minutes in English and 65 minutes in Hindi on computer.

6. **Detailed Medical Examination**:-

After preparation of merit list, the candidates selected in order of merit (category-wise) will be put through a Detailed Medical examination to assess their fitness. Some additional candidates may be called to cater the shortfall to arising due to absence of candidates for medical examination or medical unfitness of the candidates.

7. **Review Medical Examination**:-

Review Medical Examination in respect of candidates who have found unfit in Detailed Medical Examination to assess their fitness.

- 2. In all cases, a candidate declared UNFIT in Detailed Medical Examination, will be communicated the grounds for such rejection by indicating "Parameters measures" and "Standard normal parameter" in legible language by the Medical Board. The candidate, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal for Review Medical Examination within a period of 15 days with a proof of his/her fitness in the prescribed form attached as per Annexure-VII to the appellate authority. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidates has already been declared unfit for appointment in the CISF by a Medical Officer. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee of Rs.25/- through demand draft. (the details of authority to whom the appeal should be submitted and DDO concerned and payable branch etc will be mentioned in the Rejection Slip itself to be issued by the Examining Medical Officer/Chairman of the Recruitment Board)
- 3. For stenography test, the candidates are required to bring their own shorthand note book and pencil.

VII. FINAL SELECTION

Final selection of the candidates will be made from the candidates those found fit in the medical examination strictly according to merit and availability of vacancies.

VIII. HOW TO APPLY
