INFORMATION BULLETIN (COUNSELING) All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)-2016 (For ONLINE and ONSPOT Counseling)

Counseling

- For 15% of All India Quota seats in the Veterinary Colleges shall be conducted by the Veterinary Council of India.
- For seats (other than 15% All India Quota) under the control of participating States shall be conducted separately by the respective States/ University.

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Veterinary Council of India is a statutory body established under Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (52 of 1984) and charged with the responsibilities of regulation of Veterinary practice, preparation and maintenance of Indian Veterinary Practitioner's Register, regulation of minimum standards of Veterinary education and matters connected therewith.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 22 read with clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 21 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984, the Council with the prior approval of the Central Government has framed Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education - Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Regulations, 2008.

As per the provisions of regulation 7(7) of the aforesaid Regulations, the Veterinary Council of India conducts **All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)** for filling up 15% of All India Quota seats in the Veterinary Colleges in India (except from Jammu & Kashmir State).

Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur and Rajasthan States have also participated in All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)-2016 for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H Course for filling up State Quota seats (other than 15% All India Quota) in their Veterinary Colleges.

2. EXAMINATION & RESULT:

The All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)-2016 was conducted on 14th May, 2016 and the result was declared on 20th June, 2016. **Number of Candidates appeared and placed in Merit/ eligible for Wait List** for filling up 15% of All India Quota seats are as follows:

4. DURATION OF COURSE:

The duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course is spread over five complete academic years consisting of First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Annual / Board examinations including compulsory rotating internship of six months or as prescribed in relevant regulations.

5(a) ALL INDIA QUOTA & NUMBER OF SEATS:

The counseling for candidates placed in Merit/ eligible for Wait List for filling up 15% All India Quota seats shall be conducted by the Veterinary Council of India and College shall be allotted to the candidate according to the choice and availability of seat at his/her rank.

The selection of candidates for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course under 15% All-India Quota shall be applicable to the Veterinary Colleges in India (except from Jammu & Kashmir State).

The eligibility criteria, various documents etc. of the candidate shall be verified by the allotted College at the time of reporting/ admission and the decision of the college in the matter shall be final. However, in case of any dispute, the candidate shall inform the matter to the Veterinary Council of India in writing within 2 days from the date of reporting and he/she shall ensure that the intimation in this regard has been received by the Veterinary Council of India. The decision of the Veterinary Council of India in the matter of dispute shall be final.

The College/Category wise number of seats available at each round of counseling under 15% All India Quota for the academic year 2016-17 shall be made available on Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in.

The conditions relating to start of academic session, tuition and other fees, deposit and refund of fees, if any, may vary from College to College and shall be applicable as per rules and regulations of the respective College/University concerned.

Any loss of academic, financial or any kind due to change of college will be at the candidates' own risks and costs. The VCI shall not be responsible in the matter.

The Council has no role to play in this matter after allotment of seat/college.

5(b) PARTICIPATING STATES & NUMBER OF SEATS:

The Counseling for admission in seats (other than 15% All India Quota) under the control of participating States i.e. Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur and Rajasthan States in their Veterinary Colleges shall be conducted as per the notifications issued separately by the respective States/ University.

For participating States, College/Category wise number of seats (other than 15% All India Quota) for the academic year 2016-17 shall be available under the control of participating States. For detail information the respective States/ University may be contacted.

**6. RESERVATION OF SEATS IN VETERINARY COLLEGES UNDER 15% ALL INDIA QUOTA:
(Reservation would be applicable to the castes mentioned in the Central list of SC/ST/OBC)**

- (a) 15% seats are reserved for SC candidates,
- (b) 7.5% seats are reserved for ST candidates,
- (c) 27% seats are reserved for non-creamy layer OBC candidates in Central Educational Institutions only as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 10.04.2008. Reservation would be applicable to the castes mentioned in the Central list of OBC.

Note: In pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 10.4.2008 and according to detailed instructions of the Ministry of Human Resource Development issued vide their O.M. No. 1-1/ 2005-UJA/847 dated 20.4.2008 it has been decided to implement OBC reservations in respect of seats being contributed to the All India Quota by the **Central Educational Institutions** only.

OBC candidates from creamy layer and do not come under Central List of OBC shall be considered under Unreserved category.

- (d) 3% seats are reserved on horizontal basis for Physically Handicapped candidates as defined physical disability in the Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education - Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Regulations, 2008.

7. GUIDELINES FOR Persons with Disability(PwD) CANDIDATES:

A candidate shall not be allowed admission to B.V.Sc & A.H. degree course including those admitted under 15% reserved quota of Veterinary Council of India if he/she suffer disabilities in physical fitness as listed below:-

- a. Disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50%,
- b. Disability of lower limb of more than 50%,
- c. Disability of upper limb,
- d. Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability,
- e. Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- f. Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of duties of a veterinarian.

Note: The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorised Medical Board comprising of atleast three specialists out of which two should be of the speciality concerned and the candidate has to present him/her – self before the Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates. The format of Locomotor Disability Certificate to be produced is given in **Appendix-III**

8. IMPERSONATION :

During the process of counseling/admission, if it is found that candidate indulged in any case of impersonation i.e. not matching the photograph/ signature/ videograph/ documents of the candidate etc. he/she will be handed over to the Police and the cases will be dealt as per the Indian Penal Code in this matter and if required. Such cases will be handed over to CBI for further investigation and **the candidate will be debarred permanently from taking All India Pre-Veterinary Test in future.**

9. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH COUNSELING UNDER ALL INDIA QUOTA :

(a)The allotment of Seats shall be made through **ONLINE and ONSPOT counseling** as follows :

- **1st and 2nd Round - Through online**
- **3rd Round - OnSpot by Personal Appearance**

The detail Schedule of Counseling through online and onspot by personal appearance is given on the Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in.

Date wise Candidate's details and Venue for OnSpot Counseling by Personal Appearance shall be displayed on the Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in after completion of 2nd round of online counseling.

No separate intimation regarding counseling will be sent to the candidates individually.

The candidates are advised to visit Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in for latest instructions from time to time.

(b) Allotment/ Counseling will be held as per the Category Rank (UR/SC/ST/URPH/SCPH/STPH) only and the seats will be allotted to the candidates as per the 2200/3200 point Reservation Roster.

The allotment of seat shall be made on the basis of merit and subject to availability of seats in a particular Veterinary College at the time and date of allotment. **Allotment shall be closed immediately after the seats reserved for the purpose are filled.**

The Allotment/ Counseling of OBC candidates shall be done along with the candidates of Unreserved (UR) category i.e **Unreserved+OBC category candidates shall be considered together as per their Category rank only.**

(c) The candidates allotted seats should produce the following documents in original along with self attested copy of the documents for verification at the allotted College at the time of reporting/ admission and at the VCI office during onspot counseling failing which they shall not be entitled for admission at the allotted College and onspot counseling.

- Confirmation Page **(OR)** Admit Card downloaded from Council's website.
- AIPVT-2016 Result downloaded from Council's website.
- Proof of Admission in the College (Fee receipt by those who have been allotted seats during 1st/2nd round of counseling during onspot counseling)
- Date of Birth Certificate (if Secondary School Examination Certificate does not have the same)
- Secondary School Examination or equivalent Certificate
- 10+2 Mark Sheet (Qualifying Examination Mark Sheet)
- 10+2 Certificate or Provisional Certificate (Qualifying Examination Certificate). **Provisional certificate is permissible for those candidates who had passed in the year 2016 only.**
- Character Certificate from the School or College last attended,
- Proof of identity (Voter ID Card/Aadhar Card/ID Card of College or School)
- Four passport size coloured Photographs **(same as uploaded on the Online Application Form)** and One Postcard size coloured Photographs **(same as uploaded on the Online Application Form).**

The Candidate should also produce the following certificate in original, if applicable, at the allotted College at the time of reporting/ admission and at the VCI office during onspot counseling:

- (i) SC/ST Certificate as per format given in **Appendix-I** issued by the competent authority and should be in English or Hindi. If it is in regional language then it should be translated in English/ Hindi and should be attested by Class I Gazetted Officer. Sub-caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
- (ii) OBC Certificate as per format given in **Appendix-II** should be issued by the competent authority and should be in English or Hindi. If it is in regional language then it should be translated in English/ Hindi and should be attested by Class I Gazetted Officer. The sub-caste should tally with the Central list of OBC. OBC Candidates should not belong to Creamy layer.
- (iii) The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorised Medical Board comprising of atleast three specialists out of which two should be of the speciality concerned and the candidate

has to present him/her – self before the Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates. The format of Locomotor Disability Certificate to be produced is given in **Appendix-III**

- (iv) The candidates from Jammu & Kashmir who have uploaded Self Declaration claiming their eligibility under 15% All India Quota shall have to submit an affidavit as per **Appendix-IV** on Non Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- duly attested by Metropolitan Magistrate/ First Class Judicial Magistrate.

Note:

- (a) The candidates who fail to register his/her name for Counseling on the Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in within the stipulated time shall forfeit the claim for a seat under All India Quota.
- (b) The candidates, who fail to report/join the allotted college by the last date of reporting / joining, shall forfeit his/her claim for a seat under 15% All India Quota. No extension of reporting/joining time will be allowed by the Council under any circumstances.
- (c) **There shall be 1st and 2nd round of allotment through Online Counseling and 3rd round through On Spot Counseling by Personal Appearance.**

The candidates who have been allotted seats in the 1st round of allotment and have joined the allotted colleges may participate in the 2nd /3rd round of counseling for change of college, **if interested**. They must give their willingness in this regard to allotted college at the time of admission and ensure that their willingness is registered online at the time of joining the College allotted to them in 1st round of Counseling. Those who shall not registered their willingness; they shall not be allowed to participate in next round of counseling for change of college. Similar procedure is to be followed at the time of taking admission during 2nd round for participation in 3rd round.

In case of non reporting for admission to the allotted college or if candidate resigns after joining during 1st round, the vacancies caused would be filled up in 2nd round of counseling.

In case of non reporting for admission to the allotted college or if candidate resigns after joining during 2nd round, the vacancies caused would be filled up in 3rd round of counseling.

- (d) Candidate should report for admission to the Dean/Associate Dean/Principal of the Veterinary College.
- (e) **Under any circumstances candidates without ORIGINAL certificates/documents shall not be allowed to participate in counseling or take admission at the allotted College.**
- (f) **The College shall check the eligibility and authentication of the candidate and his/her documents before admission.**

10. PROCEDURE FOR AIPVT-2016 COUNSELING FOR ALLOTMENT OF SEATS :

The counseling of AIPVT- 2016 will be conducted in three rounds (1st & 2nd round –online and 3rd round onspot by Personal Appearance).

Candidates have to first register themselves for participating in AIPVT-2016 counseling in the Council's website www.aipvt.nic.in. Candidates who are registered shall only be considered for counseling for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course under 15% All India Quota.

Candidates who shall not registered themselves for Counseling shall NOT be considered for Counseling for allotment of seat.

The Counseling for admission to 15% All India Quota seats shall be conducted by a **Counseling Committee** and the decision of the Committee in respect of seat allotment shall be final.

The seats will be allotted to candidates as per their rank, choice, availability, reservation policy, etc. The round wise procedure of AIPVT-2016 counseling is mentioned below:-

10.1 Registration of Candidates for Counseling : (Only by those placed in Merit/ eligible for Wait List)

Candidates have to first register themselves for participating in AIPVT-2016 counseling in the Council's website. The registration can be done by entering requisite information like name, date of birth, roll number, application number etc. in relevant fields. Candidates who are registered shall only be considered for counseling for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course under 15% All India Quota.

10.2 AIPVT-2016 counseling Round 1- Online:

During the round 1 of AIPVT 2016 counseling, only the registered candidates have the option of choice filling and locking. Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats.

The criteria for eligibility and non-eligibility for round 1 is given below:

(a) Exercising of Choice Filling and Locking – The choice for Veterinary colleges can be selected and locked by candidates by clicking on save button. While exercising choices for colleges, candidate can interchange their opted choices number of times. But once the choice is locked and saved by candidates they cannot be either changed or unlocked. Once the choice is locked by candidates, the list of selected Veterinary colleges as per choice will appear on the screen for printing.

(b) Process of Seat Allotment – The seats will be allotted to candidates according to their rank and in order of choice opted for Veterinary colleges.

(c) Publication of Result for allotment of seat of round 1 –The candidate can check his/her result on the Council's website aipvt.vci.nic.in by **clicking link Result Round 1**. The result will have the detail of allotted college to candidates as per their merit of choice and rank.

(d) Reporting to Allotted Veterinary College – Candidates have to report to allotted Veterinary colleges within the given dates to complete admission formalities.

Candidates who shall not report after seat allotment in round 1 at allotted Veterinary colleges shall not be eligible for counseling in further rounds

10.3 AIPVT-2016 counseling Round 2- Online:

During the round 2 of counseling, only the registered candidates have the option to change/alter their choices as selected in round 1 and can also submit new choices (if not changed, earlier choices submitted by the candidate will be taken as final). Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats. **In round 2 there will be no new registration.**

The criteria for eligibility and non-eligibility for round 2 is given below:

- (a) **Exercising of Additional Choice Filling, Choice Alteration and Locking** – The choices for Veterinary colleges can change/alter as selected in round 1 by the candidate and can also submit new choices. There after the choices can be locked by the candidates by clicking on save button. While exercising choices for colleges, candidate can interchange their opted choices number of times. But once the choice is locked and saved by candidates they cannot either be changed or unlocked. Once the choice is locked by candidates, the list of selected Veterinary colleges as per choice will appear on the screen for printing.
- (b) **Process of Seat Allotment** – The seats will be allotted to candidates according to their rank and in order of choice opted for Veterinary colleges.
- (c) **Publication of Result for allotment of seat of round 2** –The candidate can check his/her result on the Council's website aipvt.vci.nic.in by **clicking link Result Round 2**. The result will have the detail of allotted college to candidates as per their merit of choice and rank.
- (d) **Reporting to Allotted Veterinary College** – Candidates have to report to allotted Veterinary colleges within the given dates to complete admission formalities.

Candidates who shall not report after seat allotment in round 2 at allotted Veterinary colleges shall not be eligible for counseling in further rounds

10.4 AIPVT-2016 counseling Round 3- ONSPOT BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE :

The venue and detail schedule of onspot counseling by personal appearance shall be displayed at Council's website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in.

During the round 3 of counseling, only the registered candidates shall be considered for onspot counseling.

Personal appearance for Counseling shall not automatically guarantee admission to a Veterinary College. The candidate who fails to appear in person on notified date and time for whatsoever reason shall forfeit the claim for a seat under 15% All India quota and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.

The allotment of seat shall be made on the basis of seniority in merit and subject to availability of seats in a particular Veterinary College at the time and date of allotment. **Allotment shall be closed immediately after the seats reserved for the purpose are filled.**

Allocation letter will be given to the selected candidates on the day of Counseling. There is no provision for re-counseling and there shall also be no provision for change of seats once allocated to a candidate.

On the notified day for personal appearance against ranks, the allotment will be made in order of merit and as per the Reservation Roster, out of seats available for allotment. The candidate will have to fill up a form at the time of his/her counseling and will have the right to choose any one of the available seats at his/her rank or reject the available seat and forfeit the claim for a seat under All India Quota.

Allotment letter will be issued on the same day of counseling after the allocation of the seat to the candidate who appeared in the counseling in particular session itself.

The candidate who fails to appear in person or who reject the available seat at his/her rank, on the notified date shall forfeit the claim for a seat under All India Quota. Similarly a candidate, who fails to join the allotted college by the last date of joining from the date of personal appearance, shall also forfeit the claim of a seat under All India Quota.

The criteria for eligibility and non-eligibility for round 3 is given below:

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All the seats remaining vacant after the process of allotment of 3rd round of counseling or falling vacant thereafter due to any reasons shall be filled up by the State.

11. REPORTING TO THE COLLEGE AFTER ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

The selected candidates shall have to report for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course at the allotted Veterinary College immediately as directed and submit the joining report. No relaxation of time on any ground shall be allowed.

In case of failure on the part of the candidate to join within the stipulated period, the seat allocated shall be forfeited and no claim thereof shall be considered under any circumstances.

12. MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS:

- In the matter of allocation of seat/admission of candidate to respective College/Institution, **the decision of the Conselling Committee shall be final.**
- All disputes pertaining to allocation of seats in various colleges by the Council shall fall within the jurisdiction of Delhi.**
- No oral enquiry would be entertained by the Council. Candidates are requested to communicate in writing. They must take special care to indicate their category rank, roll number, name and postal address and also sign the same in their letters.
- The Council is not obliged to enter into any correspondence with the candidates, unless it is considered necessary.
- Canvassing directly or indirectly for allotment of seats or adjustments thereafter would disqualify the candidate for admission on the basis of this examination. Influencing the staff by unfair means would lead to serious consequences for all concerned. The candidates or their relatives visiting VCI, New Delhi for seeking change of the allotment would face disqualification, since such visits would be treated as trespassing. Candidates appear in the counseling through forged means or by producing fabricated/tempered documents will be dealt with as per Law.
