Applications are invited from **Male Indian citizens** for filling up the following vacancies of Asstt. Sub Inspector (Fitter/Motor Mechanic/Auto Electrician) in Central Industrial Security Force. They will be governed under CISF Act and Rules as well as Central Civil Services Rules applicable to other members of the Force and other Acts and Rules applicable from time to time. On appointment they shall be entitled for the pension benefits as per the “**New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme**” applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government services w.e.f. 01-01-2004.

**NOTE :**

1. The recruitment is open to all **MALE Indian Citizens only**.
2. The vacancies may increase/decrease without any notice depending upon the position at the time of final selection. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC categories is available as per extant Government orders and as communicated by Ministry of Home Affairs. In accordance with the DOPT OM No.41018/2/2011-Estt(Res) dated 22-12-2011, 4.5% reservation for Minorities will be available from within the 27% reservation for OBCs.
3. The posts are temporary but likely to become permanent.
4. **Selected candidates are liable to be posted any where in the country according to transfer policy of the Force.**
5. The recruitment will be conducted on All India basis.
6. **Vacancies reserved for Ex-Servicemen will be filled up by direct open market candidates, if suitable Ex-Servicemen do not turn up.**

Note I: The crucial date for determining age limit will be the closing date for receipt of application from the candidates i.e. <b>05.02.2013 including for the candidates of North East region.</b>
	<b>EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION</b>	
	i)	Matriculation or equivalent examination of a recognized University/Board.

i)	Havildar or equivalent ranks in the Army or Air Force or Navy having trade of Fitter/Motor Mechanic/Auto Electrician are eligible to apply for the post of ASI/Fitter/Motor Mechanic/Auto Electrician and having trade of Certificate.
ii)	<b>‘Ex-servicemen’</b> means a person who has served in any equivalent rank (whether as a combatant or as a non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Reserve Engineering Force, the Lok Sahayak Sena and the paramilitary forces; and  (a) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or (b) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; Or (c) who has been released, otherwise than on his own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment; or (d) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency, and has been given a gratuity, and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, of the following categories, namely:- (i) pension holders for continuous embodied services; (ii) gallantry award winners.
iii)	The Territorial Army Personnel will be treated as Ex-servicemen with effect from 15-11-1986. 	Final selection of candidates will be made according to availability of vacancies and subject to their declaring “ <b>FIT</b> ” in the medical examination.
	<b>e) <u>APPEAL AGAINST MEDICAL UNFITNESS</u></b>
