2. Your application for appearing in the Admission Test (e-Chat 2017) to be held on the month of May 2017, must reach us positively 10 days before the exam. The time of the Test would be mentioned in your ADMIT SLIP. Please check the Website for the test date and centre details (www.iihm.ac.in)

3. Admit Slip would be sent to individual candidates by e-mail & Speed Post / Courier. The Institute does not take the responsibility for non-delivery of the Admit Slip due to postal delay or wrong e-mail address.

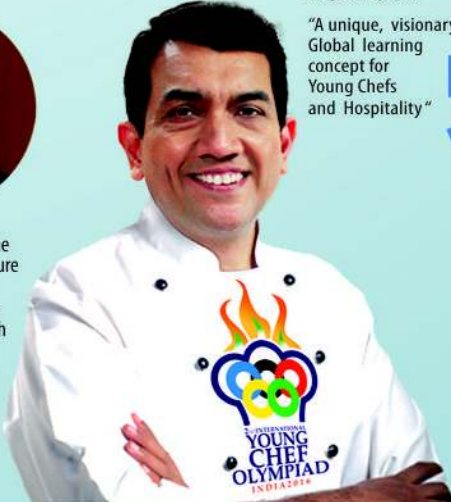
