Parking

Parking will be permitted at the under mentioned areas

Main Building (for VVIP, VIP & Board members only)

Parking lot near Type-I building (For special guests / press/ media)

From Hostel 10 to TCS area and also Campus School lane on one side of the road. (For faculty / parents /staff / others)

Parking slot in front of Physics / KReSIT Parking side of Hostel-10. (For parents /staff / others)

Parking slot in front of Earth Sciences Dept. (For parents /staff / others)

Traffic Restrictions

Faculty and staff are requested not to bring their cars to the Convocation Hall.

Heavy Vehicles viz. private buses / trucks / cement trucks, etc will not be allowed to enter from Hostel 10 junction to NCC Junction

No vehicle will be allowed to be parked from Hostel 10 to NCC junction.

Road from Hostel - 10 junction to NCC junction will be restricted for outside vehicles between 07.00 am and 07.00 pm

Bus Routes

Tum Tums shall keep on playing from Main Gate to Y-Point gate with a stoppage at Physics Dept and Gulmohar Cafeteria, to facilitate the movement for parents and students in campus.

Parking of Physics Department and the road towards the Y-Point gate from the Physics Department shall be used for the vehicles parking, both two wheeler and four wheeler.

All invitees / students / parents of students (only those informed) attending Convocation function will park their vehicles in the designated parking area and move to Convocation Hall.

Parents of other students, who have received invitation card will be taken to the Lecture Hall Complex – 1,2,3 & 4 and their vehicles would be parked in designate places.

Security Help Desk will be set at Hostel 10 junction with security staff to direct the students, guests, parents, etc. to various Convocation venues.

Baggage / Electronic gadgets / Water Bottle / Eatables will not be allowed inside the Convocation Hall. Baggage can be kept in the cloakroom of Security Office (Main Building)
