Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) came into existence as the first rural University of U.P. State and one of a few in rural area based Institutes of higher learning in India. It enjoys recognition as a 'deemed to be' University, accorded by the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development U/s 3 of UGC Act, 1956 vide Notification No. F.9-42/2005-43 (A), dated June 27, 2008.

It was basically conceived by the First Prime Minister of India, Late Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru who laid the foundation stone of Nehru Gram Bharati on 26th July, 1962 in the village of Rishi Durvasa Ashram in Dubawal, Jamunipur, Kotwa Complex of his Phulpur Parliamentary Constituency in the Prayagraj district. His dream was translated into reality by Shri. J. N. Misra, a former bureaucrat turned social thinker and philanthropist, who had the vision and dedication for upliftment of rural masses through education.



More than 5000 students study in the Deemed University pursuing different courses in different fields. We have more than 70 acres of land, spruced computer labs with internet facility & more than 40,000 books in fully digitalised library. Regular university Bus service operates in and around Prayagraj and adjoining areas. The Vishwavidyalaya has its own 24 room Girls Hostel in the rural setting at Jamunipur. Admission Policy

All the admissions in the Nehru Gram Bharati are made strictly on merit as determined on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the ENTRANCE TEST/DIRECT INTERVIEW, conducted by Nehru Gram Bharati.

Admission Procedure for Academic courses on the basis of Merit & Direct Interview

Manual Application form: A common application form for all such academic programmes where admission is made on "The basis of merit", followed by direct interview by Admission Committee, can be obtained from Registrar's Office at Nehru Gram Bharati, Kotwa-Jamunipur-Dubawal, Prayagraj or Administrative Office at 104F/3, Malviya Road, George Town, Prayagraj or City Campus 3rd, Floor, P-Square (Adjacent to Bus Stand), Civil Lines, Prayagraj-211001 on any working day on cash payment of Rs. 350/- only.

Eligibility for admission:

For admission in M.A., the students must have passed B.A. degree with one of the subjects in 3rd year in which, he/she is seeking admission.

For admission in M.Com., the students must have passed B.Com. degree from any recognised University.

For admission in M.P.A. Music (Vocal), and (Tabla) the students must have passed B.P.A. Music (Vocal) degree from any recognized University.

For admission in M.Sc. (Maths/Physics/Chemistry/ Zoology/Botany) the Student must have passed B.Sc. with respective subjects in 3rd year from any recognized University.

Admission Procedure

(Academic Courses through Entrance Test)

Application form: A common application form is

applicable to all such academic courses at undergraduate and postgraduate levels where admission is to be made through Entrance Test strictly on merit basis. The Prospectus and application form can be obtained on cash payment of Rs.800/= from the Admin. Office at Malviya Road, George Town, Civil Lines, Kotwa-Jamunipur-Dubawal, and Hanumanganj campuses Prayagraj.

Important: Pattern of Entrance Examination Papers



B.Ed. Course: The question paper will consist of Objective type questions. The Entrance Exam will be divided into two question papers:

Paper -I : General Knowledge & Language

The question paper will be of 2 Hrs. duration compulsory for all the applicants. It will have two sections, **Section - A** General Knowledge and **Section - B** Language Paper, Each Section will have 40 questions of 80 marks.

Paper-II : Aptitude test & Optional Subject

The question paper will be of 2½ hours duration compulsory for all the applicants. The paper will have two sections.

Section - A : Aptitude Test and Section - B Optional Paper. Each section will have 40 questions of 80 marks. The Optional paper will contain questions related to (Arts, Commerce, Science and Agriculture Group). The candidate is required to attempt questions related to their Subject Group as marked in the application form by the candidate.

Other Courses : There will be only one question paper of 2½ hours duration, divided into two sections which will contain Objective type questions related to Aptitude test (Section-A) and Optional Subject (Section-B) and each section will have 50 questions of 150 marks.

Entrance Test Result: Separate merit list will be prepared for each category following prescribed roster system based on the total marks obtained by the candidates in the entrance test for the purpose of admission.

Counselling : Counselling of candidates as per the ranking in each category will be done for admission to various courses mentioned above.

Refusal of Admission:

1. Candidates found using unfair means in the entrance test of the Nehru Gram Bharati shall be disqualified and debarred from seeking admission in the deemed to be university, in future.
2. It is the responsibility of the candidate to furnish complete and correct information in the application form. Any admission made on the basis of wrong or concealed information supplied by the candidate or due to any oversight or error of the ET and examination division which is subsequently detected after the admission or joining of the candidate, will be cancelled at any time at the cost and risk of the candidate.
3. Candidates against whom disciplinary action has been taken and who have been found involved in any sort of established criminal offence in the past.
4. If the admission of the candidate is not in the interest of the Nehru Gram Bharati, the Vice-Chancellor reserves the right to cancel the admission of such a student irrespective of the fact that he/she fulfils the academic requirement of the courses. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final and legally binding on the candidate.

Library

We have a fully digitalized automated central library, situated in the main campus having more than 40000 books covering all major subject areas having a sitting campus, capacity of more than 100 students at a time. Our reading room has large range and additions of newspapers, magazines, journals and other important write-ups which serve students in a purposeful manner. Besides central library there are departmental libraries too, especially for professional subjects. In addition some departments have book bank facility. A new state of the art library building having two stories, covering an area of more than 2000 square meter approx. is coming up at our research centre at Jhuti Tali. This will be synonymous of a modern library equipped with latest gazettes.
