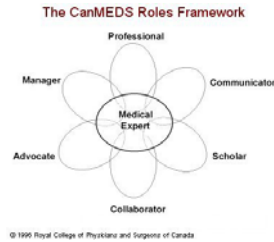

ABOUT US

Trainees in our program spend the majority of their time in St. Joseph's Health Centre, where our 42 bed level II and III newborn units are located. Together with our Obstetrics colleagues, we provide antenatal and newborn care to a population of 1.4 million in Southwestern Ontario.

With over 3,700 births per year in our center, approximately 825 newborns require admission to NICU. About 10% of our admissions are transported from referring hospitals.



Our clinical teaching faculty includes Pediatric Subspecialists, Pediatric Surgeons, Radiologists, Neonatal Nurse Practitioners, Neonatal Nutritionist, Lactation Consultants, Neonatal Pharmacist, Physiotherapists, Respiratory Therapists, and Social Workers.

Trainees in our program have access to world-class research faculty and facilities in London. Research training and mentorship is available in a broad spectrum of fields, ranging from clinical epidemiology, clinical trials, and medical bioethics to molecular biology, proteomics and genomics.
