Brief History and Background of the Institution :

The Utkalmani Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Rourkela. The first and foremost Institution of its kind in the North-western Tribals dominated zone of Odisha, was established in the year 1975 with the **basic purpose of teaching and training the students** on the 4 ½ Years' course leading to award of DHMS (Diploma in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) under affiliation to/ control of the State Board of Homoeopathy, Odisha. The Institution which came into existence by the efforts of a group of dedicated Social workers, Philanthropists and enthusiasts was 1ST started functioning in a building allotted by the RSP (SAIL) authorities at Golghar, Sector- 5 & later it got shifted to its present site (Nayabazar, sector-21, Rourkela 10) in 1992. The Institution was primarily managed by a local body /Governing Body headed by the ADM as the Chairman and comprising the Principal as the Ex- Officio Secretary, with the local MLA, MP, & representatives of the Govt. as well as the Vice Chancellor of Sambalpur University as the Members.

The mission behind establishment of this Institution was promoting and propagating the science of Homoeopathy through implementation of better standard of Homoeopathic Education & Training, for which it has been striving all along to improve its standard in all possible ways till this time. The Institution has an attached 25 bedded hospital which renders charitable medical service to the suffering people in and around the steel city.

The Institution introduced the 5 ½ yrs' BHMS (Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) degree course under affiliation of the Sambalpur University since 1981-82 academic session and also got recognized by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi, the Apex Regulatory body that designs/ stipulates syllabus for the DHMS / BHMS Degree & Post Graduate course & the standard of Homoeopathic education in the country since 1973 in terms of Faculty, Infrastructure including accommodation, equipments, accessories, a running hospital for training and education etc. It is following the syllabus and conducting examinations as per Guidelines stipulated by the Sambalpur University.

Primary attention of the managing authority during the private management of the Institution was centered on improving its academic and infrastructural standard in the light of the Minimum standard stipulated by the Central Council of Homoeopathy and as a result, even after Govt. take over the sprit of development is still on.

The college alongwith its 25 bedded attached hospital was fully taken over by the Govt. of Odisha, Deptt. of Health & F.W., during the esteemed Chief Ministership of Shri Biju Pattnaik, on 06.12.1994.

Since its affiliation to the Sambalpur University the curriculum and examinations of this Institution are conducted as per the Syllabus and norms / guidelines stipulated by the Sambalpur University and in confirmity with the norms / guidelines stipulated by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi.

Imparting education on the BHMS degree course for $5\frac{1}{2}$ years as per syllabus prescribed by the Sambalpur University / C.C.H.
