



## About KSOU

## DISTANCE EDUCATION

### PHILOSOPHY AND INSTRUCTIONAL SYSTEM IN DISTANCE EDUCATION

**Self Learning Materials:** Distance Education simply means imparting education from distance. In this system of education the teacher and the candidates are physically separated. The salient feature of instruction in distance education includes the following :

Candidates are supplied with printed materials written in a self-learning mode. Course material is specially designed by a team of experts from industries, faculty from leading institutions and in-house faculty of the University. The curriculum designed is subject to strict scrutiny by the content experts and experienced professors before adoption by the University.

Whenever necessary video/audio CDs supplement printed material. They can be in the form of lectures, debates, discussions, colloquiums etc.

**Academic Counselling:** Counselling is an important activity in distance education. It is totally different from conventional classroom teaching. Counsellors answer the candidates' questions in these sessions besides clarifying their doubts help them overcome difficulties, which they may face while going through the text. These counselling sessions also give candidates an opportunity to interact with their peers.

**Assignments:** Assignments are an integral component of distance education. Assignments serve the purpose of evaluation of the candidate's comprehension. The local counsellors evaluate these assignments and also provide feedback on the candidate's performance. A copy of the evaluated assignment will be shown to the candidates by the co-ordinator as a part of learning activity.

**Practice Session:** Depending upon the subject, an optimal amount of practical training is also imparted to candidates in study centers.

**Project Report:** The candidates prepare a project report as a part of the curriculum requirement of Post Graduate and Under Graduate courses and submit the same during the respective final semesters for evaluation and assessment.

## ACADEMIC SYSTEM

**Support Services through Study Centers:** Study centers are being set up all over the country to provide the candidates a platform to interact with counsellors, other candidates and for use of the library and technology based learning. Candidates would be getting personal attention at these centers in addition to the hands-on-training on computers at these centers

### Program Delivery

**A multi-form of Instruction has been adopted, comprising of:**

**Print material:** Study material for all subjects which are supplied in the form of books. Study material will be supplied through CDs or online media wherever necessary

**Counseling Sessions:** Will be held at Study centers, to suit the convenience of the candidates.

**Practical Sessions:** Will also be held at the Study centers

**Assignments:** For assessment, evaluation and for feed-back of the students on comprehension of study material.

**Project work:** To enable the candidate to gain an insight to independent working on a practical project.

**Credit System:** The University follows the 'Credit System' for all its programmes, Each credit entails approximately 30 hours of study comprising of all activities, Thus, a 3-credit course involves 90 study hours, This helps the candidates to understand the academic efforts he/she has to put in suitably to complete the course.

**The Grade System:** For each semester, Grade System as given in the table below is adopted for declaration of results.

In addition to Grade System, marks obtained in each paper shall also be announced, For the award of class for the Bachelor's degree courses, the cumulative performance of the candidates in the last 4-semesters (3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th) will be considered, For the award of class for the Master degree courses, the cumulative performance of the candidates in 2-semesters will be considered

**Instructional System:** The methodology of instruction in this Open University is different from that of the conventional Universities. The Open University system is more learner-oriented, so much so, the candidate has to be invariably an active participant in the teaching-learning process. The instructions are imparted through distance as well as face-to-face mode.

## General Admission Process for Distance Learning Program

### Step 1

Student has to procure a copy of student prospectus cum application form. It can be obtained either from nearest YGen Career Development Centre or can be downloaded from the website: [www.ygencdc.com](http://www.ygencdc.com). Only the current year application forms will be accepted. Application form issued in the previous years will be rejected.

### Step 2

Student has to submit the filled in application clearly mentioning the course he/she desires to enroll for. Under no circumstance your application will be transferred to another program for registration. Separate application is to be submitted for each program.

While submitting the application the student must carry the original Date of Birth Certificate, original certificates as per the eligibility criteria of the course, to be verified by the centre coordinator. The photocopies must be self attested and submitted with the relevant total course fees for the 1st semester or 1st year as the case may be in the form of Demand Draft paid in favour of "The Finance Officer, KSOU, Mysore" payable at Mysore.

Before submitting the prescribed fees students must make sure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the program applied for. Applications by ineligible candidates will be rejected. The fee once remitted will NOT be refunded.

### Step 3

The centre coordinator would verify the application form, original documents and DD.

### Step 4

On satisfactory verification of the above the student must fill Identity Card. The signature of the centre coordinator must be present on the Identity Card at the appropriate place. Registration no. will be issued along with the Identity Card

### Step 5

The centre coordinator would properly assemble all documents and send in good condition to YGen corporate address in Bangalore.

### Step 6

YGen on receiving the above would coordinate with the University and get it verified and approved from Directorate of Distance & Continuing Education of the University.

### Step 7

University on finding all documents and DD satisfactory would sign the Identity Card and return the same to YGen.

### Step 8

YGen would maintain the record of the student and return the Identity Card to the centre. This would complete the admission process. If any malpractice is found in the document submitted at the time of admission or at a later stage, admission will be cancelled.

### Identification Card

Identification card will be issued to the students after admission. The card should be produced on demand during the contact programs, for getting hall ticket for examinations and at the time of getting marks statement and other certificates. Hence, the students are advised to keep the card with them till the completion of the course.

### Duplicate Identification Card

If the original identity card is lost, duplicate identity card will be issued on production of a DD for Rs. 170 with a requisition letter, a recent passport size photograph & self addressed stamped envelope for Rs. 10.

### Enrollment Number

Enrollment number will be allotted to the students admitted in the YGen Career Development Centre at the time of admission.

Enrollment number shall be used for examination also. The students are advised to keep the identity card safely as the same has to be produced for attending contact program, examination and during issue of certificate. Any loss or damage of the card need to be informed immediately and application for a duplicate card should be applied.

## General Admission Process for Distance Learning Program

### Study Material

Study material will be issued to those candidates who have paid the entire fee in full at the respective CDC. Comprehensive printed study material specially designed for self study for both theory and practice component will be provided semester or yearly as per the course. Students will have to collect their study material pertaining to their program along with the program guide.

The study material is designed and conceptualized by the YGen team consisting of IIT-IIM Alumni and industry veterans in association with the University.

### Change of Study Centre

The students who want to change the YGen CDC should submit their application enclosing the DD for Rs. 1000 drawn in favor of YGen Management Consulting Pvt. Ltd, payable at Bangalore along with no objection certificate obtained from the previous YGen CDC.

## Student Support Services

### Administrative Support

#### Public Information

Comprehensive and easy to understand publicity material has been developed by the way of brochures, pamphlets & e-mailers will be shared with students giving general information about the practices of the University, courses offered, time lines of important events and so on.

#### Registration

In view of helping the distance education students who are geographically scattered, registration and other admission procedures will take place via the study centre

#### Personal Contact Program

Personal Contact Program is one of the most highlighting factors in course delivery. It is highly recommended for each and every student because:

Students are requested to study lesson materials before attending the classes so that they can interact and clear their doubts.

## Technology @ YGen

There has been substantial evidence around the world that technology has become one of the most important and vital components to education and in recent past is playing a vital role in distance education. In fact, it is safe to say that modern distance education would be incomplete without access to technology that can deliver information via the Internet to students in multiple locations. In other words the IT will take away the “distance” from distance education.

The **Student's Perspective** (without the use of technology in education)

In the absence of technology the students are facing the following problems:

They are missing vital information of new courses and changes in industry

They do not know what exactly to learn

They go to classes that get cancelled without any notification and most time get mediocre faculty to teach them

All of these decrease the motivation level and interest in education of the students.

The **Teacher's Perspective** (without the use of technology in education):

In the absence of technology the teachers are facing the following problems:

They do not know what students are doing

They have difficulty in spreading information

They find difficult in reaching students

A majority of teachers themselves are either not updated or are under-qualified and due to lack of information & knowledge they do not benefit from new advances and continue to teach outdated material

They have often complains of high work load

Applications designed to facilitate distance learning are available to student and teacher at YGen:

These programs integrate material and organize it so it can be accessed from computers

Students can record lessons and access presentations, slides and notes at their convenience

Security protocols allow only registered students to access content

Assessment programs provide secure testing environments with automated grading and instant feedback.

### **Y-Axis (Collaborative Learning Management System)**

Y-Axis enables students to express themselves differently than they have ever before. Students are no longer limited to using a piece of paper and a pencil or pen, but instead have a unique online environment in which they can express what information they have been able to gather, internalize data and then integrate it into their assignments.

Students have access to up-to-the-minute, current information, and this information is shared with their peers and faculty. This leads to a dramatic change in the learning experience. Teachers, who used to be the subject matter experts, will transfer more of the learning process and responsibility to students.

## B.A. and B.Com. OPEN DEGREE PROGRAMMES

### Eligibility for Admission

Admission to B.A/ B.Com Degree Programme is made under two regulations:

#### Regulation-I B.A/B.Com

For candidates seeking admission under this regulation no educational qualification is prescribed. Those who have completed 18 Years of Age on **1st July of the year of admission** are eligible to apply for B.A/B.Com Degree Programme (no relaxation even for one day). All eligible candidates will be admitted to First Year of the respective Programmes. The duration of Programme is THREE YEARS.

Note : Candidates seeking admission under Regulation I shall also study B.P.P. (Bachelor's Preparatory Programme) before appearing for the First year B.A/B.Com Examinations conducted by the University. They shall also pay an additional fee (for B.P.P Course Material) of Rs.500.00 along with First year B.A/B.Com Tuition Fee.

### PROOF OF AGE

(a) Original SSLC/SSC marks card or Transfer Certificate showing Date of Birth.

or

(b) An extract from the Admission Register maintained in a school and certified by the Head of the Institution concerned

or

#### Regulation - II B.A

Admission to the First Year of Three Year B.A. Degree Programme is open to candidates who have passed:

(a) The Two Year Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Education Board in Karnataka State;

or

Any other examination considered as equivalent there to;

or

(b) Candidates from other states who have successfully completed 12 years of schooling (either 10+2 or 11+1 or Higher Secondary Examination - 12 Years of schooling excluding Nursery education)

or

(c) Pre University Examination in Vocational Courses conducted by the Department of Vocational Education, Government of Karnataka

### Direct Admission to Second Year B.Com

Candidates who have passed the Three year Diploma in Commercial or Secretarial Practice conducted by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka are eligible for admission to Second Year B.Com. directly. However, they have to pass language papers and Indian Constitution, Human Rights and Environmental Studies - (ICHRES) of First year B.Com

### Direct Admission to Final Year B.Com

Candidates who have passed the Three Year Diploma in Business Administration conducted by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka are eligible for admission to Final Year B.Com. However, they have to pass Language papers and Indian Constitution, Human Rights and Environmental Studies - (ICHRES) and FCA of First and Second Year B.Com. before completing Final Year B.Com. Such students will have to compulsorily study and pass all the papers of Final B.Com., Examination

## B.A. and B.Com. OPEN DEGREE PROGRAMMES

### Second or Final Year B.A./B.Com Direct admission (For other University Students)

(1) Candidates seeking enrolment for Second or Final Year B.A / B.Com Programme shall pay the Tuition Fee not later than the Date announced in the particular Academic Year. Details of the payment of fee may be obtained from the respective study centres or from the University directly.

(2) Candidates seeking admission directly to Second and Final B.A / B.Com will have to study ICHRES of 1st Year and Fundamentals of Computer Application of Second B.A/ B.Com in addition to the subject in second and final year B.A respectively and pass the examination.

**Candidates admitted to First Year B.A / B.Com Programme are eligible for promotion to Second Year even if she/ he fails or not appeared for any or all the papers of First Year. She/he is eligible for promotion to Final Year if she/he fails or not appeared for any or all the papers of First Year and Second Year**

### Other Information

(1) The maximum duration for the completion of B.A/B.Com Programme shall not exceed two times the duration (Six years) of the particular Programme, from the date of admission to the Programme (including the year of admission).

(2) Candidates who discontinue their studies for more than four academic years after joining a Programme shall have to seek fresh admission.

(3) Candidates who are admitted to BA, Bcom under regulation - I shall undergo Bachelor's Preparatory Program (BPP). Study material for BPP will be supplied at the time of enrollment
