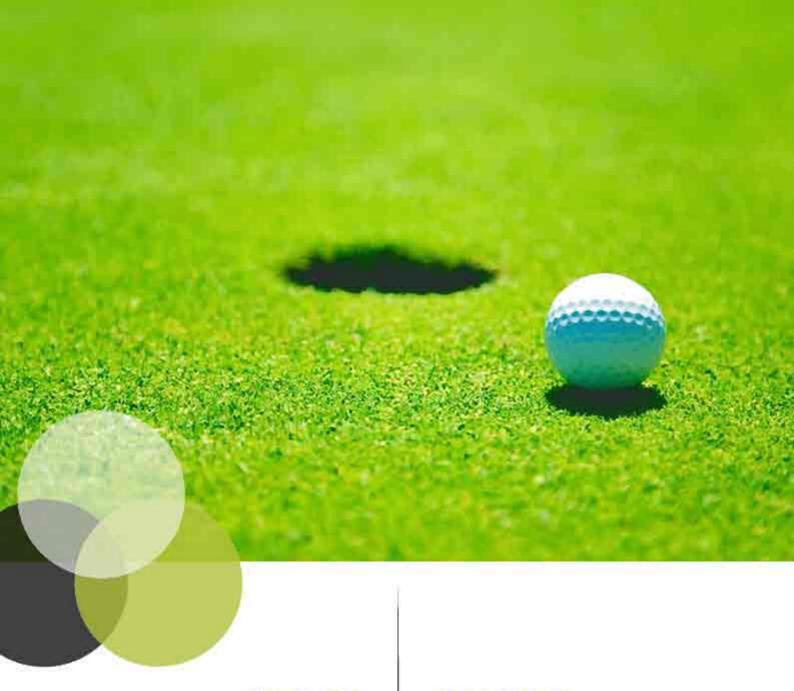

NITT OVERVIEW

During the second five year plan (1956–60) in India, a number of industrial projects were contemplated. To ensure enough supply of trained personnel to meet the demand for these projects, the decision was taken to start Regional Engineering Colleges (RECs), at the rate of one in each major state, which can churn out graduates with good engineering merit. Thus, seventeen RECs were established from 1959 onwards in each of the major states.

The Regional Engineering College at Tiruchirappalli was founded in 1964 as a co-operative venture between the Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu. In 2003, the institution was granted Deemed to be University status with the approval of the UGC/AICTE and was renamed National Institute of Technology. The Chairman of the institute is Dr.Rajaram Nityananda, an eminent Astrophysicist of TIFR. Dr.Srinivasan Sundarrajan has been the Director of the institute since July 2011. The institute is undergoing accelerated growth through the World Bank -funded Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme.

NITT offers undergraduate and graduate programmes in disciplines spanning engineering, science, architecture and management. The institute has 16 departments with more than 375 faculty members.

PLACES TO VISIT

The 83m high ROCK FORT is the only outcrop in the otherwise flat land of the city. The rock is one of the oldest in the world-approximately 3.800 million years, which makes it as old as the rocks of Greenland and older than the Himalayas. The sheer abruptness of its rise is a thrill in itself, but the actual centre of attraction is not the fort itself, of which very little remains, but the temple at the summit. 344 steps hewn out of rock lead to the top where there are inscriptions dating back to the 3rd century B.C.





The district's most important pilgrim centre is located in an island just 7 kms from Tiruchi. SRIRANGAM, surrounded by the waters of river Cauveri on one side and its tributary kollidam on the other, is a 600 acre island-town enclosed within the seven walls of the gigantic Sriranganathaswami Temple. Most of it dates from the 14th to 17th centuries, and many people have had a hand in its construction, including the Cheras, Pandyas, Cholas, Hoysalas and the rulers from Vijayanagar. The largest gopuram in the first wall on the southern side was completed as recently as 1987, and now measures 73m.

Not far from the island is one of the greatest engineering marvels of India. The GRAND ANAICUT built by Karikalan Chola in the 2nd century A.D. to harness the waters of the Kaveri. Made of stone, the dam is 329 m long and 20m wide and still very much in use. Additions have been made in the form of a road bridge on top of the dam. This is a good picnic spot.





The PERUVUDAIYAR KOVIL OR BRIHADEESWARAR TEMPLE, also known as Rajarajeswaram at Thanjavur in the state of TamilNadu, is the world's first complete granite temple and a brilliant example of the major heights achieved by Cholas kingdom Vishwakarmas in temple architecture. It is a tribute and a reflection of the power of its patron RajaRaja Chola I. It remains as one of the greatest glories of Indian architecture. The temple is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Great Living Chola Temples".

THE LOURDE'S CHURCH, TRICHY is a replica of the famous Church in France known as Basilica of Lourdes. The Church in France is known for its curative value and therefore for the believers, the Basilica of Lourdes is the right place to find solace from their bodily pains.
