#### **SEATS AVAILABLE**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION**

- Category 1: Candidates having M.Phil with Fellowship.
- Category 2: Candidates without M.Phil, but having Fellowship.
- Category 3: Candidates with or without M.Phil, but not having any fellowship. Such candidates are eligible for University's Non-NET Fellowship, but number of fellowship is limited as per University rules.
- Category 4: Foreign students (except any degree acquired in India) with their national or other fellowships recognized by the University or sponsored by their employers, may be given provisional admission, followed by confirmation through due process after a stipulated period of time.

Category 5: Teachers in a Department / Constituent Colleges of the

University of Delhi holding a permanent, temporary or ad hoc positions and

having completed two years of service as teacher.

Category 6: Permanent teachers / employees in other recognized

Universities / Colleges / Research Institutes in India and have a minimum of

three year teaching/ research experience, will be considered if they get study

leave for a period of two years to fulfill residency requirements of the University

of Delhi.

Category 7: Candidates sponsored by their employers shall be considered

only if they get study leave for a period of two years to fulfill residency

requirements of the University of Delhi. Provided however in order to advance

research in strategic areas of national concern, scientists / professionals

working at defense and space institutions/organizations of the Government of India/State Government and with whom the University has signed a

Memorandum of Understanding, will be allowed to pursue PhD while working in

their organizations provided that the DRC recommends that their work in their parent organization is relevant to their PhD research. Such students may also

be exempt from the requirement of course work under this Ordinance if

recommended by the DRC.

MODE/ METHOD OF ADMISSION

Stage 1: Screening of Research Proposal

Stage 2: Interview

Candidates under categories 1 and 4 will appear directly for interview. Candidates

under categories 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 will submit research proposal for screening, and

only short listed candidates among them will be called for interview. The final list for

admission will be drawn solely on the basis of performance in the interview.

Each proposal will be blind reviewed and screened by a panel of three experts drawn

from various specializations in the field of geography, from within or outside the

university. Only those proposals, which are vetted by at least two of the three experts, will be shortlisted for interview.

To maintain anonymity, names of scholar, supervisor and advisers should be mentioned only on the cover page along with topic of proposal. For the purpose of identification, only the topic of proposal should be indicated inside the main body.
