## 1. Reasoning

On this reasoning part there will be verbal & nonverbal reasoning questions. Generally, the type of questions that are asked in this part can be made us into decision making, analogy, blood relations, syllogism sitting arrangement, statement reasoning and series completion.

## 2. English Language

English language proficiency is examined in the IBPS Clerk Written Exam under the following grounds:

- Passage correction
- Reading comprehension
- Rearrangement
- Error detection
- Idioms & phrases
- Active& passive voice

## 3. Numerical Ability

You will not be questioned like as a graduate or postgraduate level in the numerical capability part. It will be asked to test for your general power. Therefore, getting your basics right up to standard 10th will be enough while planning for IBPS Clerk Written Exam. Most of the questions that are asked in this numerical ability part are like

- Arithmetic part includes permutation & combination, numbers, percentage, probability, time and distance, logs, etc.
- Data interpretation involving interpreting charts & tables.

#### 4. General Awareness

This part is conducted to test for general knowledge. The questions are related to banking knowledge & current events. The marks for current affairs are more than compared to banking.
