Air conditioned classrooms, state-of-the-art Information Technology Center, well stocked and fully automated library, conference halls, and plenty of open space gives the infrastructure a vibrant ambience which is highly congenial for the professional growth and development of students.



Global Auditorium: Well designed, fully-equipped, air-conditioned modern and spacious auditoriums provide a very conducive climate for learning. Auditoriums are equipped with modern Audio-Visual equipment with 24-hours Wi-Fi facility.

IT Infrastructure: The entire JGU campus is Wi-Fi enabled with the coverage of academic blocks, faculty and student housing. There are more than 200 access points, providing excellent coverage in all areas where the network is needed.

Global Library: The Global Library signifies a pro-active approach for aiding the teaching-learning process at JGU. An area of approximately 20,000 square feet has been provided for the development of the library in the T-2 block of the academic building in the campus. The library has a collection of about 45,000 print volumes and an array of electronic resources. The print collection includes books, monographs, research reports, law reports and back volumes of periodicals, among other study material. In addition to professional reading material, the library offers a large collection of leisure reading and books for the development of soft skills. The print resources of the library are divided into 'General Collection' and 'Reference Collection'.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Eligibility and Selection Criteria (IBM)

- Minimum of 60% aggregate marks (all subject) in 10+2 examination or equivalent.
- Performance in a national/ international level test (SAT/ UGAT/ JAT etc.) and demonstrated excellence/ leadership in co-curricular and/ or extra curricular activities.



Eligibility and Selection Criteria (MBA)

- Bachelor's (any subject) with minimum of 50% aggregate marks (graduating students may cite latest scores).
- Applicant must have taken one of the following tests: CAT, MAT, ATMA, CMAT, XAT or GMAT.
- Selection will be based on test scores and demonstrated excellence/leadership in cocurricular and/or extra curricular activities such as debates, quiz, sports, cultural, events, NGOs etc.

INTEGRATED BBA-MBA (5 YRS)

The objective of the Integrated BBA-MBA 5-year Degree programme is to enable students to embark upon a management career after completing 10+2 level examination. The programme provides students with a comprehensive understanding of the fundamentals of business management and the opportunity to pursue chosen areas of specialization.

The design and delivery of this integrated program is innovative and unique. It will equip students with the knowledge and skills necessary to compete successfully for challenging positions in industry, government, non-profit organizations and civil services. This programme will create excellent managers and also instill the spirit of entrepreneurship so that the students evolve into leaders and wealth creators in the years to come.






